Roll to Play




First, users will need to log into their BoardGameGeek account.


Home Page

On the home page, users can view easy-to-access information or can tap "Let's Play" to begin their roll. Under "Usual Parties," players can reroll their common rolls and under "Recommended" users can see their recommended games for the day. They can also view all their parties or all of their collection from this page.



Let's Play

Here, the user will use the dropdowns and sliders to select the number of players, length of time you want to play, and the difficulty level. The user can select "any" for the time and the difficulty level if they are indifferent. At the bottom, they can see a recap of the information they've input. Then, they tap "Roll!"



You Rolled

Now, the user will see their result! They will see a photo of the box so they know what it looks like, the title, and a description. Underneath they can find the player count, time to play, and difficulty of the game with the matching icons and colors used throughout the app. If they don't like the choice, they can reroll, or they can tap play and log the play on their BoardGameGeek account.
